Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	Network: \$2,000 Individual / \$4,000 Family Out-of-Network: \$4,000 Individual / \$8,000 Family Per calendar year.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , the overall family <u>deductible</u> must be met before the <u>plan</u> begins to pay.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> is covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost-sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	Yes, Prescription drugs - Network Pharmacy <u>deductibles</u> : \$2,000 Ind / \$4,000 Fam. What is the <u>out-of-pocket</u> <u>limit</u> for this <u>plan</u> ?	Network: \$2,000 Individual / \$4,000 Family Out-of-Network: \$5,000 Individual / \$10,000 Family Per calendar year.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> must be met.
What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit?</u>	<u>Premiums</u> , <u>balance-billing</u> charges, health care this <u>plan</u> doesn't cover and penalties for failure to obtain <u>preauthorization</u> for services.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket</u> limit.
Will you pay less if you use a <u>network provider</u> ?	Yes. See <u>myuhc.com</u> or call 1-866 314-0335 for a list of <u>network providers</u> .	This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the <u>plan's network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the <u>provider's</u> charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays (<u>balance billing</u>). Be aware, your <u>network provider</u> might use an out-of- <u>network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services.
Do you need a <u>referral</u> to see a <u>specialist</u> ?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes

If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.
