- The EPC is growing, and we are pleased to welcome our newest Foodservice Consultants, Geremy Kerr & Hallie Jay!
  - O Geremy is a Registered Dietitian with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and dual master's degrees in Food and Nutrition Sciences and in Dietetics and Nutrition. - We have the 2025-26 bid results from our food service bid solicitation. We presented the 2025-26 bid results at the EPC Food service Bid Meeting on June 4, and the results have been posted on SWEPC.org. We included two new vendors: Avalon & Imperial Dade, both of whom came in with aggressive pricing.
- Ohio Budget Continues Reduced Price Meal Reimbursement Through Fiscal Year 2027
  - The new biennial state budget continues reimbursing schools \$0.30 for breakfast and \$0.40 for lunch for each meal served to reduced-price eligible students. This provides reduced-eligible student meals at no cost. The reimbursement to schools is paid as part of the monthly claim.
- EPC Important Dates:
  - The SWEPC Commodity Co-op is enrolling now through October 15<sup>th</sup> for the 2026-2027 school year! This long-standing program has been in place for over 25 years, with over 80% of Ohio districts utilizing it to receive and track their government commodities.
    - Members of the Co-op benefit from being able to attend meetings covering key topics including White/Dark Meat Balancing, Entitlement Calculation & Maximization, Q&A Sessions, Vendor Participation & New Item Sampling.
