Liability Fleet & Property Insurance – Ken Swink reported that after 14 years with Arthur J. Gallagher we have moved on to World Risk Management for our EPC Liability, Fleet & Property Insurance program. Our renewal meeting will be held on May 9th at Aullwood. As we continue to experience a hard insurance market, we are working to ensure our members receive the very best coverages for the lowest premium possible.

Utilities/Natural Gas – Ken Swink reviewed our current year natural gas hedge for 70% of our load at \$2.7322 per MMBtu. Pricing approached \$10.00 last fall, but extremely mild weather after our polar plunge over the Christmas break has allowed current market prices to moderate considerably. Unfortunately, the futures prices for next school year are still north of \$4.00 and the following year north of \$4.50. We will continue to share updates from our consultant, Mark Jergens as he continues to search for hedging opportunities for the next two school years.
