

The Farmers' Almanac VS the Old Farmer's Almanac

Ohio Winter for 2025-26

The Farmers' Almanac predicts a very cold and snowy winter for all of Ohio, while the Old Farmer's Almanac forecasts a colder-than-normal winter for the Ohio Valley region and a milder, drier winter for the northern Lower Lakes region. Both almanacs have different forecasts for the 2025-2026 winter, with the Farmers' Almanac predicting generally colder and snowier conditions throughout the state, while the Old Farmer's Almanac suggests a split forecast based on region.

Farmers' Almanac

- **Winter:** Very cold and snowy throughout the state, with a "healthy amount of snowfall" and a "wet fall season" leading to a "white finish".

Old Farmer's Almanac

- **Winter:** Forecasts a split season for Ohio.
 - **Ohio Valley Region (southern Ohio):** Colder than normal with below-normal precipitation and more snow in the east.
 - **Lower Lakes Region (northern Ohio):** Milder than normal with above-normal temperatures and below-normal precipitation.
- **Spring:** Warmer than normal temperatures and above-normal precipitation in the east but below-normal in the west.
- **Summer:** Warmer than normal with below-normal rainfall.
